



On Farm Pick Up Transportation Service Agreement

This On Farm Pick Up Transportation Service Agreement ('Agreement') is between AusBulk Limited trading as ABB Grain Storage and Handling (ABN 88 007 556 256) of 124-130 South Terrace Adelaide South Australia 5000 ('ABB') and the Person or Persons named and described in Item 1 of Schedule 1 ('Contractor').

1. RECITALS

ABB carries on the business of receiving, handling and storing grain and other commodities.

The Contractor is a provider of freight services for grain and commodities.

ABB has agreed to engage the Contractor to provide road transportation services on the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

2. INTRODUCTION

The Contractor acknowledges that ABB provides no guarantee, nor makes any representation in relation to the volume of Services, which ABB may require during the Term of this Agreement.

Both Parties agree that for the purposes of this Agreement the Contractor is not deemed to be a common carrier.

The Contractor acknowledges that in performing the Services, in addition to its obligations under this Agreement, it shall comply with all lawful instructions as displayed or notified in writing, or issued verbally, at ABB sites.

3. DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

3.1 Definitions

In this Agreement (including the Recitals and the Schedules), unless the context requires some other meaning:

"**ABB**" means AusBulk Limited trading as ABB Grain Storage & Handling (ABN 88 007 556 256) and its related corporations within the meaning of the *Corporations Act (Cth) 2001*.

"**ABB Business Manager**" means the ABB Business Manager at the Locations or such other person as nominated by ABB from time to time;

"**Business Day**" means a day other than a Saturday, Sunday or public holiday in South Australia within the meaning of the *Holidays Act 1910*;

"**Code**" means the Code of Practice for the "ABB Grain On Farm Pick Up Transportation Service" as amended from time to time prepared by ABB.;

"**Commodity**" means commodities of ABB (or under the control of ABB) transported by the Contractor under this Agreement and can include (but is not limited to) barley, wheat, other cereals, pulses, cottonseed, sorghum, oilseeds, other protein meals and fertiliser.

"**Event of Force Majeure**" means war, riot or civil commotion, act of God, fire or explosion, flood or storm, landslide, lightning or earthquake, act of governmental or municipal authority, damage to or destruction of plant or equipment, strike or other industrial disturbance (other than a strike, stop work, lockout or boycott of or by the Contractor's employees, agents or sub-contractors) or any other cause which, by the exercise of due diligence, a party is unable to prevent or overcome;

"**GST**" means the tax imposed by the GST Law;

"**GST Law**" has the same meaning as in *A New Tax System (Goods and Services Tax) Act 1999 (Cth)* and associated legislation;

"**Insolvency Event**" means in relation to any person:

a. (receiver appointed) a receiver, receiver and manager, administrator, trustee or similar official is appointed over the whole or a substantial part of the assets or undertaking of the person and is not removed within 30 days;

b. (payments suspended) the person suspends payment of its debts generally;

c. (unable to pay) the person is insolvent within the meaning of the *Corporations Act 2001*;

d. (arrangements with creditors) the person enters into or resolves to enter into any arrangement, composition or compromise with, or assignment for the benefit of, its creditors or any class of them;

e. (winding up) an application (other than a vexatious application) or order is made for the winding up or dissolution of, or the appointment of a provisional liquidator to, the person or a resolution is passed or steps are taken to pass a resolution for the winding up or dissolution of the person otherwise than for the purpose of an amalgamation or reconstruction which has the prior written consent of the other party and, in the case of an application, the application is not withdrawn or dismissed within 30 days; or

f. (administrator) an administrator is appointed under Division 2 of Part 5.3A of the *Corporations Act 2001* and, except in the case of an appointment by the person or its directors, is not withdrawn or removed within 14 days;

"**Locations**" means those locations from which, and to where, the Contractor will transport particular Commodities on a day as have been agreed between the parties (whether orally, by facsimile or by e-mail), and as recorded in ABB's Operations Management System;

"**Marine Transit Insurance**" means insurance covering Commodities in the Contractor's care, custody and control carried by it for an amount of not less than \$A 30,000;

"**RCTI**" has the same meaning as recipient created tax invoice in the GST Law;

"**RCTI agreement**" means the agreement which is entered into between ABB and the Contractor for the creation and issue by ABB of recipient created tax invoices;

"**Services**" means the transportation by use of the Vehicles of Commodities by road from and to the Locations in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement;

"**Term**" means the term of operation of this Agreement set out in **Item 1 of Schedule 1** of this Agreement;

"**Vehicles**" means the vehicles that the Contractor uses to provide Services to ABB which Vehicles belong to the person identified by the Carrier Card Short Name in **Schedule 2**; and 'Vehicle' means any one of the Vehicles.

"**Website**" means www.abb.com.au

3.2 Interpretation

In this Agreement:

(a) words indicating the singular number include the plural number and vice versa;

(b) words indicating one gender include any other gender;

(c) words indicating persons include natural persons, bodies corporate and unincorporated associations;

(d) references to persons include their respective executors, administrators, successors, liquidators and permitted assigns;

(e) headings are for convenience only and do not affect the interpretation of this Agreement;

(f) the Schedules form part of this Agreement;

(g) if there is any inconsistency between a Schedule and the body of this Agreement, the former will prevail; and

(h) a reference to any Act of Parliament or to any section or provision in any Act of Parliament extends to and includes any statutory modification, re-enactment or substitution for that Act, section or provision.

3.3 Liability

Where the Contractor is more than one person, the obligations of the Contractor under this Agreement are obligations of all of those persons jointly and each of them severally.

4. ENGAGEMENT

4.1 Engagement of Contractor

ABB engages the Contractor to provide Services during the Term

on and subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

4.2 Acknowledgments

The Contractor acknowledges that ABB:

(a) gives no warranty, nor makes any representation, as to the extent to which it will require Services to be provided by the Contractor during the Term; and

(b) does not warrant or represent that it will not use other persons to provide Services during the Term.

5. PROVISION OF SERVICES

The Contractor:

(a) will make itself, the Vehicles and all necessary employees, agents and permitted sub-contractors available to provide Services; and

(i) will provide Services:

(i) on such days and within such hours during the Term as are notified from time to time by ABB;

(ii) by using the shortest possible legal road routes or any specified by ABB.

(iii) For all commodities for which designated segregating exist at the receival site;

(iv) In accordance with the requirements of the code.

6. VEHICLES

At all times during the Term the Contractor must ensure;

(a) each Vehicle is available as required under this Agreement for the provision of Services, provided that a Vehicle that is not required on a day for the provision of Services may be utilised by the Contractor for other purposes;

(b) when engaged in the provision of Services, a Vehicle must be in a clean condition, free of any material, insects or other contaminants, which might adversely affect the Commodities, or the environment;

(c) each of the Vehicles is available for inspection by ABB at all reasonable times;

(d) at its own cost and expense, to maintain each of the Vehicles in good mechanical order, condition and visual appearance to the reasonable satisfaction of ABB;

(e) that third party policies of insurance are in force in respect of each of the Vehicles;

(f) all taxes, imposts and fees relating to the ownership or use of the Vehicles have been, or will be, paid when due;

(g) each Vehicle is operated strictly within the legal load limit at all times;

(h) that the Commodities in a Vehicle are secured to prevent any of them escaping from the Vehicle whilst in motion;

(i) the provision of adequate water proof protection to prevent loss of, or damage to, Commodities being transported by the Contractor;

(j) to avoid the use of noisy engine brakes when operating their vehicles in 'built up' areas to avoid disturbing residents.

7. OBLIGATIONS

At all times during the Term, the Contractor:

(a) will comply with directions given by ABB, including any policies as attached to this Agreement or available at www.abb.com.au or set out in;

(i) ABB's 'Vehicle Operators Handbook'

(ii) ABB's 'Employee and General Contractors Safety Handbook' and;

(iii) ABB's Code of Practice for the On-Farm Pick Up Transportation Service

as amended from time to time. In addition the Contractor shall make available to all Personnel and drivers subcontracted for work under this Agreement a copy of the above Handbooks. Additional copies of Handbooks can be obtained from ABB or www.abb.com.au.

(b) shall submit a 'Vehicle Operator Registration' for any Personnel registered as a Carrier Card/driver, signed by the driver. Additional Vehicle Operator Registration forms can be obtained from ABB or www.abb.com.au.

(c) will comply with, and ensure that each of its employees, agents and sub-contractors complies with, all reasonable and lawful directions of any ABB personnel;

(d) must when on ABB property, comply with, and ensure that each of its employees, sub-contractors and agents complies with, all speed limits and all health, safety and other regulations (including smoking restrictions, clothing and footwear) as are stipulated by ABB from time to time;

(e) will carry out its obligations under this Agreement with all reasonable diligence, competence and dispatch and in

accordance with generally accepted standards prevailing in the road transport industry;

(f) will undertake ABB site induction for individuals.

(g) The Contractor remains responsible for the performance of its Personnel and will ensure that its Personnel comply with all relevant laws, acts, regulations and any associated industry code of practice, from time to time in force relating to the ownership, use or safety of the Vehicles and the provision of Services and, in particular (but without limitation), the *Road Traffic Act (1961) (SA)*, *Motor Vehicles Act (1959) (SA)* and the *Statutes Amendment (Road Transport Compliance and Enforcement) Act 2006 (SA)*

(h) must ensure that: all vehicles and drivers are registered in accordance with relevant legislation; licenses and permits necessary for the performance of the Services are current; and the Contractor is familiar with regulations regarding mass and loading requirements and driver fatigue.

(i) Will clean up any Commodities that escape from any Vehicle whilst under the Contractor's control.

8. PAYMENTS

8.1 Rate or Amount

ABB will pay the Contractor for the Provision of Service in accordance with **Schedule 1**.

8.2 Method of Payment

(a) Where ABB and the Contractor have entered into the RCTI agreement and the RCTI agreement between ABB and the Contractor continues to have operation and effect, ABB will pay the Contractor Charges against recipient created tax invoices, generated by ABB in relation to the Services provided by the Contractor during the period to which the invoice relates, in accordance with the terms set out in **Item 4** the Schedule 1.

(b) ABB may at its discretion set-off against and/or otherwise reduce or deem satisfied any obligation it may have to the Contractor to the extent of any obligation that the Contractor may have to ABB (whether present or future, certain or contingent, ascertained or sounding only in damages) on any account whatsoever.

9. GOODS AND SERVICES TAX (GST)

9.1 Consideration is GST Exclusive

Unless specifically described in this Agreement as 'GST inclusive', the consideration to be paid or provided for a supply made under or in connection with this Agreement does not include any amount on account of GST.

9.2 Gross up of Consideration

(a) Where any supply to be made by one party ('Supplier') to the other party ('Recipient') under or in connection with this Agreement is subject to GST (other than a supply the consideration for which is specifically described in this Agreement as 'GST inclusive'):

(b) the consideration payable or to be provided for that supply but for the application of this clause ('GST Exclusive Consideration') shall be increased by, and the Recipient shall pay to the Supplier, an amount equal to the GST payable by the Supplier in respect of that supply; and

(c) the Recipient must pay that additional amount at the same time and in the same manner as the GST Exclusive Consideration payable or to be provided for that supply.

9.3 Reimbursements

If any payment to be made to a party in connection with this Agreement is a reimbursement or indemnification of an expense or other liability incurred or to be incurred by that party, the amount of the payment must be reduced by the amount of any input tax credit to which that party is entitled for that expense or other liability, such reduction to be effected before any increase in accordance with **clause 9.2** (Gross up of Consideration).

9.4 Recipient Created Tax Invoices

ABB and the Contractor agree that,:

(a) ABB can issue tax invoices in respect of the supplies made by the contractor under this agreement;

(b) The Contractor will not issue tax invoices for the supplies made under this agreement;

(c) The Contractor acknowledges that it is registered for GST and will notify ABB if it ceases to be registered.

(d) ABB is registered for GST and will notify the Contractor if: ABB ceases to be so registered; or if ABB ceases to satisfy the requirements for issuing an RCTI; and

(e) ABB will not issue a document that might be an RCTI after the time either the Contractor or ABB fails to satisfy the requirements for issuing such a document.

10. INSURANCE

10.1 General Obligation

The Contractor must take out at the Commencement Date and maintain during the Term at its own expense and with reputable insurers, such types of insurance cover in such amounts as a reasonable and prudent person engaged in the road transport industry would take out and maintain.

10.2 Specific Policies

Without limiting clause 10.1 (General Obligation), the types of insurance cover to be taken out and maintained by the Contractor must include:

(a) public liability insurance extending to all aspects of the Contractor's obligations under this Agreement for a minimum of \$A20,000,000 for any one occurrence with no limit on reinstatement;

(b) comprehensive and third party liability insurance's in respect of each Vehicle owned by the Contractor (with such third party liability cover to be not less than \$A30,000,000 unless otherwise required by any relevant law);

(c) worker's compensation insurance in respect of its employees and contract drivers

(d) ABB undertakes to maintain insurance in relation to the Contractor (and ABB's other on-farm pick-up contractors); Marine Transit Insurance (loss of load or commodity contamination) for a limit of \$A1,000,000 on all grower Commodities transported from farm to ABB storage silo pursuant to this Agreement.

(e) The Contractor will be liable for an excess of \$250 per individual claim under the policy.

(f) The Contractor acknowledges that a copy of the policy is available to the Contractor upon request and that the Contractor understands that the policy contains a number of liability limits and important exclusions.

(g) The Contractor insurance policies required under (a), (b) and (c) must extend to and cover any service performed by a sub-contractor of the Contractor. If required by ABB, ABB will be noted as an additional insured on these insurance policies, which

will be placed with companies approved by ABB.

10.3 Sub-Contractor's Obligations

Where a sub-contractor is engaged by the Contractor for the purposes of this Agreement, the Contractor must ensure that the sub-contractor also complies with the requirements of **clause 10.1** and **10.2 (Specific Policies)** in respect of each of the sub-contractors vehicles used for the purposes of providing Services.

10.4 Evidence

The Contractor must provide ABB with copies of each of the insurance policies referred to in clauses **10.2 (Specific Policies)** and **10.3 (Sub-contractor's Obligations)**, together with evidence of the renewal of such insurance policies, upon request.

11. FORCE MAJEURE

11.1 No Liability

Neither party will be liable to the other for any failure to carry out an obligation under this Agreement if that failure is due to an Event of Force Majeure.

11.2 Notification

A party must give prompt notice to the other of any anticipated or actual Event of Force Majeure and must use its best endeavours to abate or overcome that Event of Force Majeure as soon as possible after it arises.

12. INDUSTRIAL DISPUTES

12.1 Contractor's Obligations

In the event of a strike, stop-work or boycott by the Contractor's employees, agents or sub-contractors:

- (a) the Contractor must give prompt notice to ABB specifying the circumstances and the estimated duration;
- (b) consult at the earliest opportunity with ABB with a view to reaching agreement on the action required to minimise the impact on the Contractor's ability to meet its obligations under this Agreement; and
- (c) use its best endeavours to comply with its obligations under this Agreement.

12.2 Termination

If, by reason of a strike, stop-work, lockout or boycott, the Contractor is unable to perform any one or more of its obligations under this Agreement for a period of 10 Business Days, ABB may terminate this Agreement at any time thereafter by giving 5 Business Days written notice to the Contractor.

12.3 Accrued Rights

Termination of this Agreement under clause 10.2 (Termination) will not prejudice the rights of either party that have accrued prior to the date of termination.

13. DEFAULT AND TERMINATION

13.1 Events of Default

Each of the following events is an Event of Default in relation to a party ('Defaulting Party'):

- (a) an Insolvency Event in relation to the Defaulting Party; or
- (b) the Defaulting Party fails to perform in a timely manner a material obligation required to be performed by it under this Agreement.

13.2 Notification

If there is an Event of Default the party not in default ('Non-Defaulting Party') will be entitled to notify the Defaulting Party in writing of the Event of Default and require the default be remedied within a period of not less than 10 Business Days.

13.3 Termination

If a Defaulting Party does not remedy an Event of Default within the time period stipulated in the notice given under clause 13.2 (Notification), the Non-Defaulting Party may terminate this Agreement at any time by notice in writing to the Defaulting Party.

13.4 Accrued Rights

Termination of this Agreement will not prejudice the rights of either party that have accrued prior to the date of termination.

13.5 SUBCONTRACTORS

(a) The Contractor will not be relieved of any responsibility under this Agreement for any obligations that are sub-contracted, and the Contractor will alone be responsible for the payment of all costs, fees, charges and expenses incurred or charged to it by any sub-contractor.

(b) Any subcontractor engaged by the Contractor for the provision of any Services must use the Contractor's Carrier Card so that the subcontractor can be identified by the Carrier Card Short Name set out in Schedule 2.

13.6 NO ASSIGNMENT

This Agreement is personal to the Contractor and the Contractor may not assign any of its rights or obligations under this Agreement without the prior written consent of ABB.

14. LOSS, DAMAGE OR DESTRUCTION OF COMMODITIES

14.1 Payment by Contractor

If, during the provision of Services, any Commodities are lost, damaged or destroyed, and the

loss, damage or destruction is, in the reasonable opinion of ABB, due to the act, default or negligence of the Contractor, its employees, agents or sub-contractors, the Contractor will, within 5 Business Days after receipt of a written notice from ABB specifying the value of the Commodities lost, destroyed or damaged ('Amount'), pay the Amount to ABB.

14.2 Deduction by ABB

If the Contractor fails to pay the Amount in accordance with **clause 14.1** (Payment by Contractor), ABB may deduct the Amount from any amounts payable to the Contractor under this Agreement, but any such deduction will not be, or be deemed to be, a waiver by ABB of the Contractor's default.

15. INDEMNITY

The Contractor will indemnify ABB from and against all losses, costs, damages and expenses suffered or incurred by ABB in relation to any:

- (a) injury to or death of any person;
- (b) loss of or damage to property of any person; or
- (c) clean up of a spill and/or damage to the environment, that arises;
- (d) in the course of the provision of Services; or
- (e) out of the Contractor's negligence or default in respect of its obligations under this Agreement.

16. NOTICES

16.1 Form of notice

Any notice under this Agreement can only be given in English, in writing and signed by the party or its agent. Except for purposes of notices of termination under clause 11.3 (Termination), notices can be given to a party in any one of the following ways:

- (a) personally;
- (b) by facsimile transmission: to the Contractor: at the facsimile number set out in Schedule 2; to ABB: at the facsimile number set out in Item 7 of Schedule 1. Notice by facsimile transmission is deemed to be received when the sending machine confirms the facsimile has been sent. A notice sent by facsimile after 5.00pm, will be taken to have been received on the next Business Day;
- (c) by mail with all postage and charges prepaid: to the Contractor: at the postal address set out in Schedule 2; to ABB: at the postal address set out in Item 7 of Schedule 1.

Notice sent by mail will be taken to have been received on the second Business Day following the date of posting.

(d) by email:

to the Contractor: at the e-mail address set out in Schedule 2;

to ABB: at the e-mail address set out in Item 7 of Schedule 1.

Notice by email is deemed to be received when the sending machine confirms the notice has been sent.

16.2 Termination Notices

For the purposes of clause 13.3 (Termination) notice can only be given to a party in writing as follows:

(a) by registered post:

to the Contractor: at the postal address set out in Schedule 2;

to ABB: at the postal address set out in Item 7 of Schedule 1.

Notice sent by mail will be taken to have been received on the second Business Day following the date of posting.

(b) by facsimile:

to the Contractor: at the facsimile number set out in Schedule 2;

to ABB: at the facsimile number set out in Item 7 of *Schedule 1*.

Notice by facsimile transmission is deemed to be received when the sending machine confirms notice has been sent. A notice sent by facsimile after 5.00pm, will be taken to have been received on the next Business Day.

17. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

17.1 Variations

ABB may amend this Agreement at any time by giving the contractor written notice of the amendment and by publication on the website. Any amendment to this Agreement will not affect any On Farm Pick Up movements entered into by the contractor prior to the date of publication of the amendment on the website.

17.2 Entire Agreement

This Agreement together with the relevant pricing schedules, published on the Website, constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior representations and agreements in connection with its subject matter.

17.3 Waivers

No waiver by a party of any of the provisions of this Agreement will be binding unless expressly made in writing, and any waiver will relate only to the matter, non-compliance or breach to which it expressly relates and will not apply to any subsequent matter, non-compliance or breach.

17.4 Severance

Part or all of any provision of this Agreement that is illegal or unenforceable may be severed from this Agreement and the remaining provisions of this Agreement will continue in full force and effect.

17.5 Governing Law

This Agreement will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of South Australia. The parties submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of South Australia.

17.6 Relationship

The Contractor is an independent contractor, and nothing in this Agreement constitutes a relationship of employer and employee, principal and agent, or partnership between ABB and the Contractor.

18. Privacy Statement

18.1 The information about the Contractor collected by ABB under this Agreement will only be used for the purposes of the performance of this Agreement and to contact the Contractor regarding important company or industry changes likely to affect the Contractor. The information will not be disclosed to third parties other than potential users of the Services and ABB's agents and contractors who need to know the information.

18.2 Failure by the Contractor to provide all or part of the information may result in the Contractor not being notified of opportunities to provide the Services.

18.3 ABB will, upon reasonable request of the Contractor, provide the Contractor with a copy of the information provided to ABB by the Contractor pursuant to this Agreement.

ITEM 1 – TERM

ITEM 2 – SERVICES

For the transportation of grain, pulses and oil seeds commodities by road from the grower registration form. The Agreement applies to all types of commodities.

ITEM 3 - VEHICLES

As required to complete the task, and shall comply with the Code of Practice for On Farm Pick Up Transportation Service.

ITEM 4 – PAYMENT

Will be by Recipient Created Tax Invoice within 30 days from date of valid On Farm Pick Up Transportation Service delivery. DO NOT SEND INVOICES. You will receive the normal "Remittance Advice" from ABB Finance Department monthly, with a summary of all RCTI's included in the payment.

ITEM 5 – RATES

ABB sets the rates (also referred to as Charges) by metric tonne, OFP Facility, Zone, Hundred location, and Address. Rates may vary by Commodity. The Company may vary these Rates and or Facilities at any time and from time to time. Carriers are advised to confirm current rates prior to commencement of load; these can be obtained at www.ezigrain.com.au or may be faxed on request from ABB Billing Services.
