Please read and familiarise yourself and your sales staff with these procedures and complete and return to ABB Seeds the attached Seed Retailer Agreement

Seed Licensing Procedures 2008

Bagged Seed

- Seed bags will display a warning that opening the bag constitutes acceptance of terms and conditions of the Grower Licence and Royalty Agreement handed to them when they purchase the seed. This replaces the requirement for the licence Agreement to be signed by you and the Grower and returned to ABB Seeds
- Retailers will be provided with copies of a leaflet titled "Grower Licence and Royalty Agreement Terms and Conditions" setting out the terms under which the PBR owner permits the Grower to produce the variety.
- Growers **MUST** be handed a copy of the "Grower Licence and Royalty Agreement Terms and Conditions" each time you sell seed of ABB Seeds varieties.
- Ensure that you have accurate records of the Name, Address, phone and fax numbers, and ABN of each purchaser of seed and the quantity of seed purchased.
- You must supply these details for both bagged seed and bulk seed sales to ABB Seeds on request, usually once each year by 30 July.

Bulk Seed (including Bulker Bags)

- As this product is not in sealed package, a licence agreement must be signed by the Grower and the retailer (as agent for ABB Seeds) prior to purchasing Seed.
- Two copies of the agreement must be signed – one handed to the grower and the other mailed to ABB Seeds.
- "Grower Licence and Royalty Agreement (Bulk Product)" forms will be provided or may be down loaded from the ABB web site at www.abb.com.au
- Jitarning Wheat - The WA Department of Agriculture requires that Growers purchasing EGA Jitarning Wheat sign a CIR Deed Poll in favour of the Department for the purpose of royalty deduction. Copies of the Deed Poll are available from ABB Seeds or the Department.
